The CAREER Program offers the National Science Foundation's most prestigious awards in support of junior faculty who exemplify the role of teacher-scholars through outstanding research, excellent education and the integration of education and research within the context of the mission of their organizations. Dr. Kyle Plunkett a current CAREER recipient, will provide insight on how to craft a proposal and address frequently asked questions.

Eligibility:

- Hold a Doctoral Degree
- Be untenured; and be employed in a tenure track position as an assistant professor by October 1st following the deadline for submission of CAREER proposals
- Have not submitted more than twice previously and have not previously received an NSF PECASE or CAREER award; can be an NSF recipient in other programs
- Work in a discipline normally funded by NSF
