Limited Submission Notification

When a funding agency limits the number of proposals per institution for a particular grant program and more researchers want to apply than are allowed, the University must decide which proposals are to be submitted to the program. To facilitate a fair decision process, researchers wanting to apply to a limited-submission program are required to submit a Limited Submission Notification form and pre-proposal to OSPA at least 60 calendar days before the agency deadline (regardless of whether the deadline is for letters of intent or for full proposals). Exceptions for specific programs, if any, will be announced on our web site or in Research Matters.

The pre-proposal should consist of:

- 2-page project description describing the scope of the project, expected/intended outcomes, the personnel involved, and existing resources;
• 1-page budget;
• 2-page curriculum vitae.

The Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research (OVCR) will establish a committee to oversee the proposal selection. (Note: Holiday breaks or other circumstances may necessitate lengthening the deadline for a particular program. Any such exception will be announced in Research Matters, OSPA's newsletter, http://ospa.siu.edu/newsletter/index.html, or on OSPA's home page.)

If the PI misses the deadline for notification, priority will be given to notifications of intent in the order in which they were received by OSPA.
